



Professor Phillip Sambrook Young Investigator Travel

Application for 2022 now open

Professor Sambrook OAM was the inaugural Medical Director of Healthy Bones Australia (formally Osteoporosis Australia) and past President of the Australian and New Zealand Bone and Mineral Society. He made an immense contribution to research and public awareness about bone health and osteoporosis in Australia, and the benefits of his commitment and passion for will be felt for years to come.

The Professor Philip Sambrook Award is a travel grant awarded annually to an outstanding early career investigator. The award offers a valuable opportunity for a young researcher to make career-advancing connections with the international bone research community. Both laboratory scientists and clinical researchers are encouraged to apply.

The HBA-ANZBMS Research Fund is now seeking applications from scientists or clinical researchers who have received their research or clinical qualification within the last 5 years.

The Awardee will receive up to \$10,000 in support of:

- ✓ Attendance to present at an international conference in a relevant discipline, including registration, economy airfares, accommodation costs and a daily living allowance; and
- ✓ Attendance at the joint meeting of the ANZBMS, Gold Coast, 2022 (including registration, economy airfares and accommodation costs).

The Awardee will also receive a commemorative award at the ANZBMS Conference awards dinner

Who can apply for the award?

To be eligible, the investigators must:

- ✓ Be within 5 years of having received their most recent research or medical qualifications;
- ✓ Have submitted an abstract to present either an oral or poster presentation at an international conference in a relevant discipline.
- ✓ Be a member of the ANZBMS or the ARA.

How do I apply?

Applications should be submitted via the application form available from the Healthy Bones Australia website.

Submissions must be no longer than 2 pages and include the abstract and a budget for the trip.

Applications must be received by 8 July, 2022.

Applications will be assessed by representatives of Healthy Bones Australia, the ANZBMS and the Australian Rheumatology Association.

Healthy Bones Australia reserves the right not to grant the award in the event that the committee does not receive an application from a suitable candidate.
